

What to do if you find used syringes

If you feel confident you can follow these steps

- Do not handle the syringe with bare hands
- Find a rigid-walled, punctureresistant container, ideally with a wide mouth and a secure lid
- Avoid carrying the syringe

 bring the container to the syringe
- Do not hold the container, place it on the ground next to the syringe
- Wear gloves and use tongs to pick up the syringe

- Carefully pick up the syringe away from the sharp end
- Place the syringe in the container sharp end first
- Do not try to break off, bend, recap or cover the sharp end
- Use the tongs to pick up any other discarded injecting equipment including packaging or swabs
- Wash hands with running warm water and soap.
