## What does a support worker do?

The day-to-day job of a support worker is built around the needs of the person you are supporting. It is full of variety and can include helping them to carry out daily tasks such as:

- personal care (showering, grooming and dressing)
- medication administration
- meal preparation
- manual handling
- transport
- purchases
- record keeping and reporting.

It can also include supporting a person to stay connected with their friends, family and the community, learn new skills, or pursue their personal interests and hobbies.

## Anglicare requirements

All Anglicare employees must be willing to obtain:

- Australian Residency status or valid Australian working rights
- Provisional or full Australian Driver's Licence and an insured, reliable motor vehicle
- Tasmanian Working with Vulnerable People registration
- National Police Check (Working with Vulnerable People)

## How does the traineeship work?

If you are offered a traineeship you will be enrolled in the Certificate III Individual Support (Disability) course. You will be provided with guidance and support to complete the requirements of your qualification.

The traineeship role is a permanent part-time position in which you will work a minimum of 15 hours a week. You must be willing and available to work a variety of shift times.
